The EHS Manager is responsible for developing, updating, and maintaining safety and environmental compliance programs, creating, and maintaining reports and validating compliance. The EHS Manager must interact with employees, contractors, and visitors and must spend a significant amount of time in the plant ensuring that all programs and procedures are appropriate and are being followed. This role sustains and improves current behavior-based safety programs and policies as well as leads and participates in all incident investigations. The EHS Manager conducts internal plant audits and develops and tracks corrective actions based upon audit findings.
